- 1) **Speech content** (have you answered all the subtopics in the outline?)
- 2) **Eye contact** (looking at the audience)
- 3) **Posture** (standing straight)
- 4) **Enunciation** (speaking clearly) and **Volume** (speaking loudly enough), and
- 5) **Rate of speech** (not speaking too fast or too slow)

As a visual aid, each of your University websites will be displayed on the projector while you are presenting.

Speeches will be given on FRIDAY 10/7 and MONDAY 10/10 (20 points).
