**Weekly Fluency Words: take, every, old, by, after, think, let
 For the daily fluency tic, tac, toe activities, students should complete one activity a different sheet of lined paper each night. The student's name, date, AND name of the activity should be at the top of the lined paper. At the end of the week, students should staple all three activities together (three pieces of lined paper total), and staple colored in tic, tac, toe board to the top with the student's name on the tic, tac, toe board.
