8.1 - End Punctuation

- Imperative and Declarative Sentence uses a period (.)
 - Imperative - gives a command (*Give me your pencil.*)
 - Declarative - makes a statement (*That was cool.*)
- Interrogative Sentence uses a question mark (?)
 - (*Do you know where my pencil is?*)
- Exclamatory Sentence uses an exclamation point (!)
 - (*That was so much fun!*)

8.2 - Commas in a Series

- Commas are used to separate three or more words in a series. The comma comes before the coordinating conjunction
 - The coordinating conjunction → and
 - The series should consist of either all nouns, verbs, adverbs, or adjectives
 - (*Scientist observe, study, **and** chart stars.*)

8.3 -Commas with Conjunctions

- A comma is used **before** the coordinating conjunctions **and, but, or**
 - *You must observe the sky, and you will see many stars*
 - *You may use a telescope, but you can also use binoculars*
 - *You can study the moon, or you can look for at stars*
- A comma is also used to separate two independent clauses to create a **compound sentence**

8.4 - Direct Address and Yes/ No

- Use commas to separate words used in direct address
 - **Beginning:** **Greg**, please get your book and take notes.
 - **Middle:** Please get your book, **Greg**, and take notes.
 - **End:** Please get your book and take notes, **Greg**.
- Use commas after the words Yes and No
 - **Yes**, that was the correct choice.
 - **No**, do not get that book.

8.5 - Apostrophes

- Apostrophes are used to show ownership or possession
 - Nancy's house
 - Students' teacher
- Apostrophes are also used as a contraction
 - He is → He's
 - You have → You've
 - Have not → Haven't
