- Poem Titles, Articles, Short Stories, Essays and Song Titles
 - Put in **Quotations**
 - “Letter to the Moon”
- Sacred Book Titles
 - **Capitalize** first letter - Bible, Torah

8.8 - OTHER USES OF CAPITALIZATION

- Capitalize the **first word** in a quotation
 - Sally said, “This is a nice day.”
- **Directions**
 - North, South, East West
- The pronoun **I**
- **Titles** before a person’s name
 - Mr., Ms., Dr., President
- **Initials** in a person’s name
 - H. G. Wells

- **Titles**
 - Sr. Jr. Capt
- **Calendar**
 - Jan, Feb, Dec,
- Time
 - Sec, min, hr
- Units of **Measure**
 - in, yd, g, cm, gal, lb
- Postal
 - Ave, st,
- States
 - WA, NY, CA

8.10 - DIRECT QUOTATIONS

- Quote at beginning, **comma before** the quote ends
 - “Get your book and take notes,” explained the teacher.
- Quote at the end, comma before the **quote begins**
 - The teacher explained, “Get your book and take notes.”
- Divided quote
 - “Get your book,” explained the teacher, “and take notes.”

8.11 - ADDRESSES AND LETTERS

- All letters have these parts
 - Heading
 - **Salutation** (Capitalize all beginning letters)
 - Dear Aunt Jane
 - Body/ Message
 - **Closing** (only capitalize first word)
 - Sincerely yours, Yours truly
 - Signature
