Use 'a' before a word that begins with a consonant sound.

- a banana
- a unicorn
- a student

- There is <u>a</u> squirrel under the tree.

Use 'an' before a word that begins with a vowel sound.

- an apple
- an igloo
- an elephant
- You have <u>an</u> hour to finish it.

Article: 'The' points out a <u>specific</u> person, place, or thing.

■ The test will start in an hour.

■ **The** first flight of the Wright brothers lasted only 12 seconds.

■ The handmade Peruvian sweaters were colorful.
