## Weekly Fluency Passages

## $3^{\text {rd }}$ Grade

Fluency means being able to read a text quickly, accurately, and with expression. A fluent reader is better able to understand the text. Rereading and reading aloud is a good strategy for becoming a more fluent reader.

## Reading Fluency Goal for $\mathbf{3}^{\text {rd }}$ Grade: $\mathbf{1 3 7}$ wcpm (word count per minute)

To practice reading fluently:

- Set a timer for one minute.
- Read the passage as quickly and accurately as possible.
- Mark the last word with a bracket ( ) read when the timer goes off.
- Record the words per minute read in the chart at the bottom.

To determine Words Per Minute, count the amount of correct words the student read in one minute. Record that number in the box.

$1^{\text {st }}$ Read - Follow along as student reads and put a slash (/) through any incorrect words. (Use RED crayon)
$2^{\text {nd }}$ Read - Follow along as student reads and put a slash (/) through any incorrect words. (Use BLUE crayon)
$3^{\text {rd }}$ Read - Follow along as student reads and put a slash (/) through any incorrect words. (Use GREEN crayon)
