ARTS: Log Cabin Project

Materials Needed on February 12:

- Pretzel Sticks
- Half-gallon waxed paper milk carton or juice box, emptied.
 - Measure 3 inches down the side of the carton. At 3-inches, draw a line around the entire carton.
 - Cut along the line and separate the top from the bottom, Discard the bottom. You will use the top.
 - Draw outline of the door and windows.

- Cut out the windows and door. You can leave one side of the door attached and fold it so that it opens and closes.
- Liquid glue
- Cardboard (size varies depending on your milk carton)
