Creative Design: Include drawings, photos, or printed images.

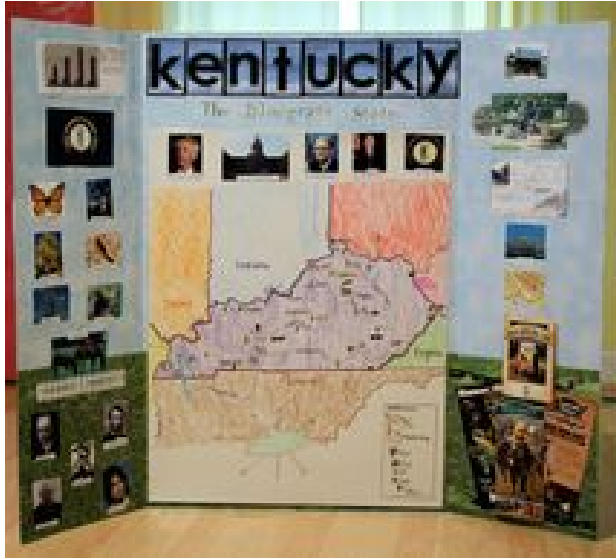
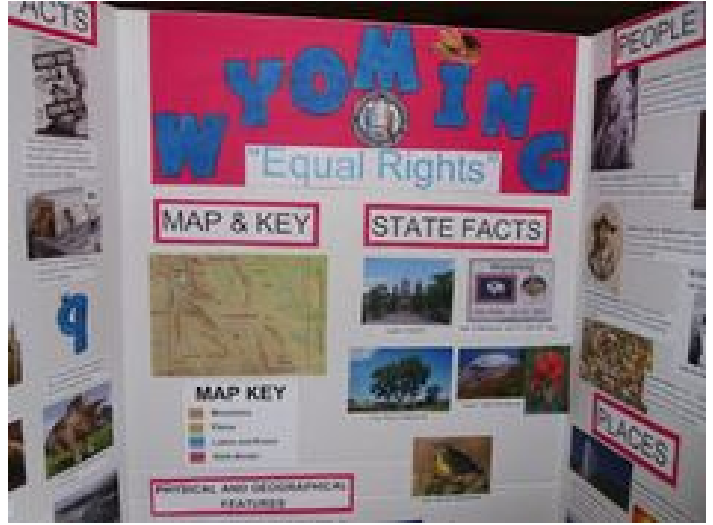
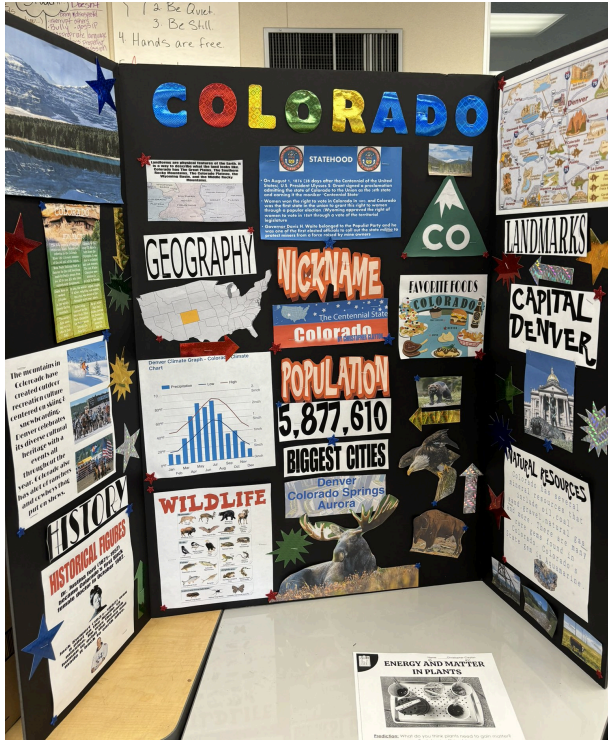
Example Ideas:
